## Five steps to apply for an Amateur & Voluntary Arts Training Award

- Read the Arts Grants & Bursaries Guidelines and Conditions carefully as it answers some common questions in relation to the Amateur & Voluntary Arts Development Award.
- 2. Fill in the application form. This gives us information about you, what you are applying for and your budget. You need to write a description of the activity you want us to support. The form also gives us information we may use to report to Sligo County Council or to monitor the different backgrounds of people who receive grants.
- 3. Online Application. If you want to fill in the application form electronically, you can get a copy from our websites (www.sligoarts.ie / www.sligococo.ie). You will need to print it out <a href="FOUR">FOUR</a> times, sign it and post it to us with the rest of your application.
- 4. Include any relevant extra information. Depending on the type of activity you want us to support, you may also need to include extra information. ONE copy of supporting information is sufficient. An Independent Panel, administered by Sligo Arts Service will assess your application using the form and any other information you provide.
