Sligo Arts Service is a department of Sligo County Council, working in partnership with Sligo Borough Council, The Arts Council of Ireland, and key stakeholders locally, regionally and nationally to deliver a high quality Arts Service for the people of Sligo. Operating from its office in Market Yard Sligo, the Sligo Arts Service team deliver a programme of arts activities covering all art forms including Public Art and provide advice, grants and information to individuals and groups who wish to set up arts projects in their own communities.

Space for Art Sligo Arts Plan 2007 – 2012 will guide and inform the planning and delivery of the arts service and annual programmes over the coming years. During this time, Sligo Arts Service plans to secure and extend the achievement of Sligo's Chamber Music Festival (currently the Vogler Spring Festival 2000-2009) taking into account the wider musical needs of the county. As producer of the annual Vogler Spring Festival and funder of Sligo Music Series, Sligo Arts Plan provides for ongoing support for the performance and promotion of chamber music of excellence. These and many other music initiatives, including a Music Education programme at primary school level, are organised and supported by the Arts Service of Sligo County Council with additional funding from Sligo Borough Council and the Arts Council of Ireland
